JOHNNY MOWLEM'S RACING TRAVELS RETURN WITH LOOK AT LOTUS AND THE ROAD TO LE MANS

LONDON (Oct. 10, 2011) – The latest episode of the hit racing docu-series Johnny Mowlem's Racing Travels will premiere Wednesday, Oct. 12 at 7 p.m. on Britain's Sky Sports network. The program will air twice the next day on Sky Sports 3 at 11 a.m. Thursday (Oct. 13) and at 1:30 p.m. the same day on Sky Sports 4.

The program will take viewers along the road to the 24 Hours of Le Mans, following Mowlem and his Lotus factory racing teammates as they prepare for and compete in the world famous race in the Lotus Evora GTE.

The Johnny Mowlem's Racing Travels series has followed Mowlem through his international racing career for over a decade. His wins in the famous Rolex 24 at Daytona and the 12 Hours of Sebring have been featured, but of greater interest to racing enthusiasts is the rare behind-the-scenes looks at the racing business.

"The Lotus Evora GTE's journey to Le Mans was fraught with pitfalls, and yet despite everything, the team pulled together and we all came through against all odds to pull off what I can only describe as one of my finest results in the seven times that I've raced in the Le Mans 24 hours." Mowlem said. "It wasn't best result as I've been fortunate enough to

stand on the podium at Le Mans before, but in terms of the number of problems that that we had to overcome and the lack of time we had to prepare for what is one of the hardest and most grueling races in the world, it is definitely my greatest finish!"

The program will show all the preparation in the weeks leading up to a race and the traveling effort, things that aren't always seen by the motor racing public.

After Wednesday's first showing, the episode will air on Sky Sports 3 at 11 a.m. Thursday (Oct. 13) and at 1:30 p.m. the same day on Sky Sports 4.
